NT Unit: A King Like No Other, Lesson 1

**D6 Family Theme:**  
THE HUMBLE KING

**Objectives:**

**Know:** The Bible teaches Christ's humanity and His divinity.

**Think:** Live with the assurance that my Lord and King is accessible to me.

**Do:** Exalt Christ as God, but also associate with Him as a respected friend.



## READ: LISTEN TO GOD

**Read Matthew 21:1-11.** While humility is an honorable trait, it is also one that is often misunderstood and overlooked. Jesus demonstrated humility, even though He was the King of Kings.



## PRAY: TALK TO GOD

We love and praise Jesus because He humbled Himself to associate with us. Pray that you and your family will realize the power and holiness that God possesses. Thank Him that even though He is King of Kings, He still understands and takes the time to have a relationship with us.



## DO: WALK WITH GOD

**Option 1:** Jesus, the King, was coming to the city of Jerusalem. People were lining the streets and placing palm branches and clothes on the ground to make way for Him. Jesus didn't make a grand entrance, but arrived humbly on a donkey. Explain to your child that being humble means you think of others before yourself. Spend some time as a family humbling yourselves and being selfless by serving others in your community. Take your family to a food bank or nursing home. Your family could also serve your neighbors by cooking them a meal or offering to do some yard work for them. It is important that your child not only serves, but sees you serving as well.

**Option 2:** Begin with this interactive game. You will mention the categories below and your family should try to guess as many answers as possible:

- *Phrases using the word humble* (In my humble opinion, humble pie, humble abode, humble beginnings)
- *Humble people throughout history* (Mother Theresa, Abraham Lincoln, Benjamin Franklin, Billy Graham)
- *Words that rhyme with humble* (Fumble, jumble, tumble, rumble)
