NT Unit: A King Like No Other, Lesson 2

**D6 Family Theme:**  
THE CRUCIFIED KING

**Objectives:**

**Know:** Jesus' death united a holy God to sinful people who trust Him.

**Think:** Live conscious of the fact that Christ's death made salvation and a relationship with God possible.

**Do:** Trust in Christ's sacrifice and live for Him in appreciation for what He has done for me.



## READ: LISTEN TO GOD

**Read Matthew 27:11-54.** People generally do everything they can to avoid pain. However, Christ voluntarily subjected Himself to horrific physical and emotional pain so we can be forgiven and spend eternity with Him where there is no pain.



## PRAY: TALK TO GOD

We worship and serve Jesus because He paid the penalty we deserved. Pray that you and your family will be more aware of the price that Jesus paid on the cross. Thank Him for the sacrifice He made so we could one day be with Him.



## DO: WALK WITH GOD

**Option 1:** Jesus was arrested, made fun of, spit on, and nailed to a cross even though He didn't do anything wrong. Jesus suffered and was crucified so that our sins could be forgiven. Ask your child to recall a time when he was made fun of or bullied. Did he do anything to deserve that treatment? How did that make him feel? Explain to him that Jesus could have felt the same way. He was being made fun of and treated badly even though He was the perfect Son of God. Jesus went through this torture so we could one day live in Heaven with Him.

**Option 2:** Ask your family the following questions to spark a discussion about pain.

- *What is the most physically painful thing you have ever experienced?*
- *What is the most emotionally painful thing you have ever experienced?*
- *Which do you think is the hardest to deal with: physical pain or emotional pain? Why?*

Teens discussed how Christ voluntarily subjected Himself to physical and emotional pain so humanity could be saved. Talk with your teen about reflecting on and worshiping Jesus for dying on the cross.



YOUNG  
ADULT

The group members discussed how Christ voluntarily subjected Himself to horrific physical and emotional pain for the salvation of mankind and were asked to reflect on and worship Jesus for dying on the cross for them.
